About workshops in Week 8-11

- Discover other groups/individuals' projects.
- **No marks for the presentation but associated with class activities (in Week 12 Tutorials):**
Students will conduct a peer review and assess one of project proposals in the tutorial.
- Each group or individual prepare one slide and give about a 5-minute speech about the project.
- You will use a ppt slide to talk about your proposal
- **A session chair** manages the time and gives a brief report to others after returning to the main room

5-minutes speech Tips

- *Introduce yourself and your topic clearly.* Indicate this on the slide and don't rush too much to give the reviewers a chance to grasp your topic.
- *Be selective about the content you include.*
- Do not rush!
- *Time management by the session chair– Keep the presentation to 5 Minutes and terminate it in an appropriate way.*
- *Students should think through their speech*
- *Remember who your audience is.*
- *Remember the different levels of expertise of your audience*
