

## Method 1. Installation of local version

You can obtain as student license for Mathematica through UTS – follow the instructions from the following link.

Note: if you are using a VPN then you may have trouble accessing the UTS Wolfram User Portal link. If so, go to <https://account.wolfram.com/login/create> and create account.

## Method 2. Using UTS Citrix Workspace

**Step 1.** First you need to download and install the Citrix browser plugin.

Go to <https://www.citrix.com/downloads/workspace-app/> and scroll down to select operating system.

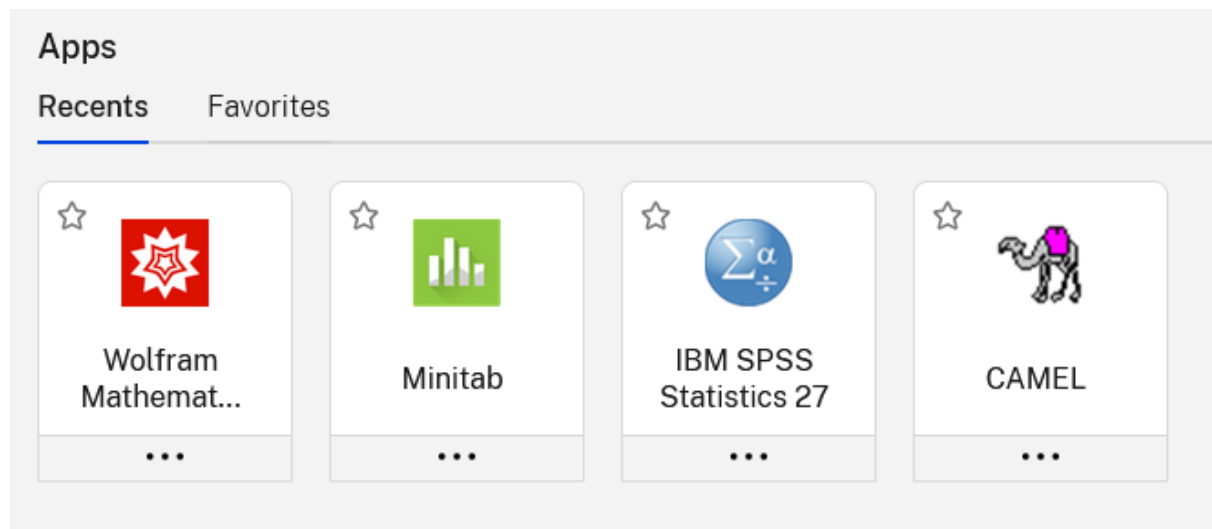

Download installation file, run and select default options (you do not need to enter email address at end of installation process).

**Step 2.** Access UTS Citrix Workspace
